



# How to access the security certificate on your browser



## Chrome

1. Click the padlock icon located at the top of your page, either within or next to the search bar.
2. Now, press 'Certificate'. The certificate contents (e.g subject, validity period, algorithms) can be found on the 'Details' tab



## Firefox

1. Click the padlock icon located at the top of your page, either within or next to the search bar.
2. You will see whether your connection is secure or not. Press the arrow then select 'More information'.
3. A pop-up tab will appear containing security details of the page. Finally, press 'View Certificate'



## Internet Explorer

1. Click the padlock icon located at the top of your page, either within or next to the search bar.
2. Now, select 'View certificate'. This will take you to a pop-up tab containing the details of the certificate.



## Edge

1. Click the padlock icon located at the top of your page, either within or next to the search bar.
2. Then, press 'View certificate'. This should bring up all certificate information on the right side of your screen.



## Safari

1. Click the padlock icon located at the top of your page, either within or next to the search bar.
2. To view more information, press 'Show certificate'. A window will appear, containing the certificate details.
